

What is an LTAC Hospital?

LTAC stands for “long-term acute care” hospital. LTAC Hospitals provide specialized care services for patients requiring extended medical care and rehabilitation. Those with catastrophic or acute illnesses and injuries can work toward recovery. These patients require a longer hospitalization—the average length of stay at the St. Francis LTAC Hospital is approximately 25 days.
