A motorized wheel chair was donated for the day for Holly from United Seating & Mobility Company.

Each year this event continues to grow. This year, thanks to a dedicated committee, lots of new ideas have been incorporated into the event. The committee includes Holly Anderson, St. Francis Health Care Centre Resident; Bill Tate and Laurey Medvick from Hart's Ambulette, Bruce Golatka & Marcus Page III from United Seating and Mobility; Dick Cook, Fremont WARTHOGS; Ken Herman with Seneca County ABATE of Ohio Inc., Jose Garcia; as well as Sue Bowden and Jean Smith from The St. Francis Hospital Foundation.

Part of the "growth" includes the ride to St. Francis. This year there will be many different rides from area chapters. All rides will gather together at the Green Springs VFW on State Route 19 at 11:30 a.m. The parade of bikes will ride at noon to St. Francis Health Care Centre.

Registration for the bike show will begin at 1:00 p.m. and cost is \$5.00, judging will take place at 2:15 p.m. and awards will be presented at 3:00 p.m. A picnic style lunch will be served from 12:00 p.m. to 2:00 p.m. Cost for lunch is \$5.00. Proceeds benefit the residents of St. Francis Health Care Centre.

Motorcycles will be judged in 4 categories: Custom, Touring, Cruiser, and Sport/Street. St. Francis resident, Holly Anderson will, once again present the Holly Award. Holly will pick her favorite motorcycle from the winner of the 4 categories. The 1st 50 registrants will receive a free Bike Day T-Shirt. Shirts will also be on sale for \$10.00.
